<p>Other Options for adopting or placing a cat CHECK REFERENCES WHEN PLACING A CAT: Ask for vet and personal references. WHEN ADOPTING A CAT: Ask for the cat's medical history/records.</p>	
<p><u>WWW.PETFINDER.COM:</u> Post pictures & info of cats that need homes online; listed by location and type/breed. <u>NEWSPAPER:</u> Run an ad, charge at least \$25/cat to screen out questionable characters.</p>	<p><u>POST FLYERS:</u> At StreetCats, PetsMart, Southern Ag, Vet Offices, work places, etc. <u>VET OFFICES:</u> They sometimes take cats and adopt them to good homes (and may have kittens for adoption).</p>
